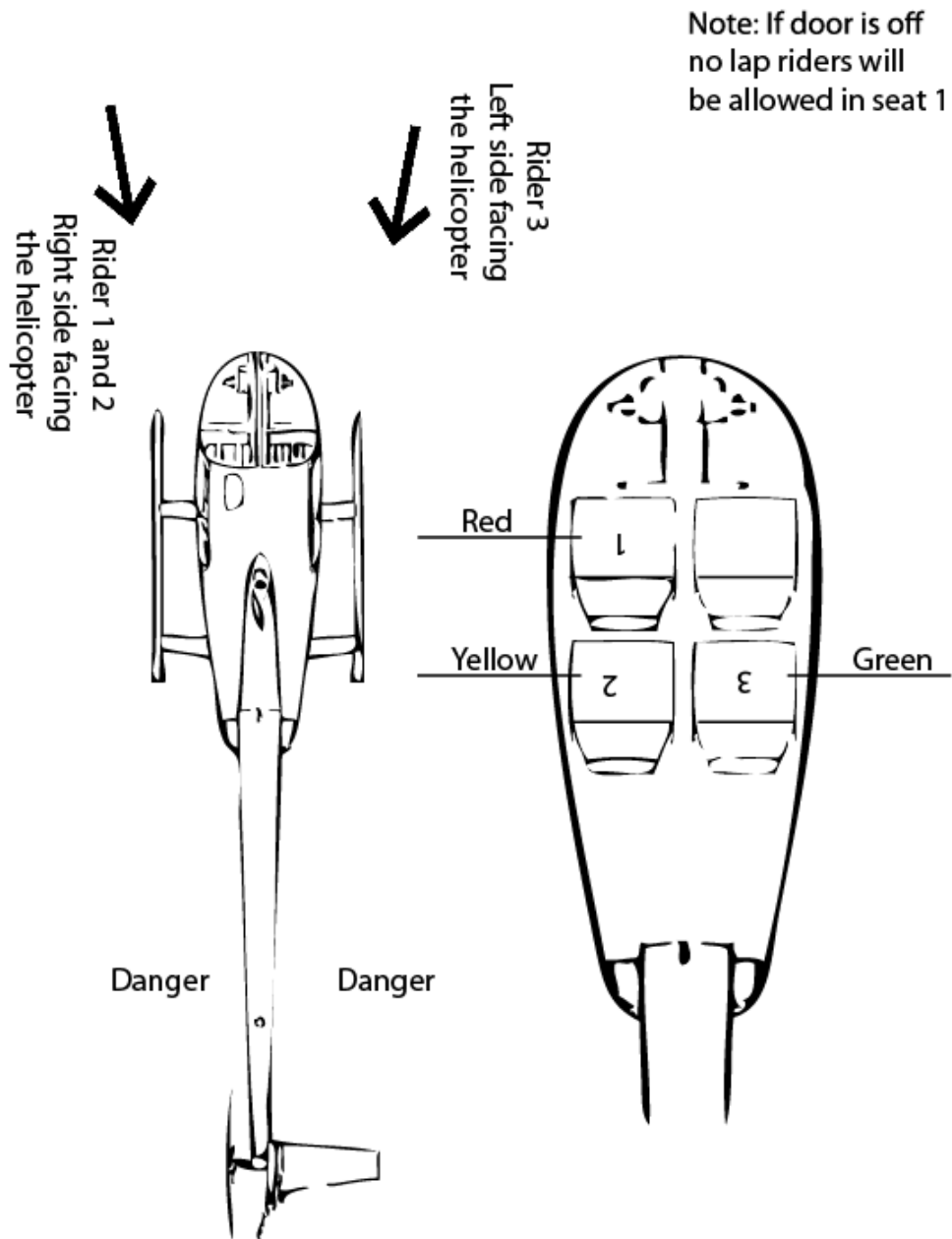


Caution: NEVER GO BEHIND THE HELICOPTER. Always stay with the martial and approach from the front



Restrictions:

~ Includes briefing on how to enter and exit the helicopter safely, and 7 minutes in the air

~You can have up to 3 adult riders and 3 children (2 and younger) who will ride on the adults lap **(*1)**.

~The seat belt must fastened across all riders (over the child if riding on an adults lap)

~Lap rider and or adult riders combined weight **must be less than the 300 pound seat**

capacity and are subject to weighing for verification. **This is an FAA requirement and strictly enforced.**

~Riders can be split into multiple rides if weight and balance is an issue.**(*2)**

~All riders should be back **at least 20 minutes in advance** of their scheduled time slot. If riders are not back for the safety brief, we will do our best to work you in (later in the day), however you will be flying "stand by".

~To reschedule please contact us at **least 48 hours in advance**. It will be subject to availability and potentially a rescheduling fee at the discretion of RAC management.

~**No Refunds except for a cancellation due to weather or mechanical breakdown.**

~ **All rides that occur within operational hours of the Clow Cavalcade of Planes require admission to the event in order to access the helicopter ride.**

~ Cost of helicopter ride does **NOT include event admission fee.**

~ While seats can be requested, final seating is at the discretion of Rent A Copter llc and its employees.

~ **Person who made the reservation must have a photo ID to identify your reservation.**

***1** If the front passenger door is off **(summer events)** lap rides will be limited to two as no lap riders will be permitted next to a removed door.

***2** If riders need to be split into multiple loads for weight and balance **additional fees may apply**. To be safe a per group weight of 675 pounds (combined weight of all riders) or less should be maintained. If you have a larger group weight than this you will most likely be split into multiple groups.

General Rules

- Whatever the PIC says goes
 - He may ask you to be quiet during specific maneuvers
- No pushing buttons / touching controls
- Hands, feet, and all body parts must remain inside at all times
- Be ready to go, wash up if necessary (especially kids)
- Food and drinks are to be left in the tent and can be picked up upon returning

Boarding

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Approaching the helicopter

- Approach angle should be from the front. NEVER BEHIND THE HELICOPTER
- Remain clear of tail-rotor at all times
- Walk towards the front of the helicopter

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Seat belt

- Must remain fastened throughout the entirety of the flight
- Arms phones etc should remain inside of the helicopter at all times

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Headset

- The operation of the Mic-boom and volume control will be covered in the pre-flight briefing.
- Pilot may use "isolation" when talking to "air traffic control". Isolation is where the pilot can "turn off passenger communication" to focus on exterior communication/piloting the aircraft

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Door latch and unlatch

- NEVER unlatch door while in-flight... danger

Unboarding

- Wait for PIC's instruction to begin un-boarding
- Hang up headset
- Wait for an assistant to unlatch the door and walk you out

Medical Statement & Release

Initial ____ **1) VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION:** I, _____ voluntarily choose to participate in flying and/or flight training activities ("flight activities") in a helicopter operated by Rent-A-Copter LLC.

Initial ____ **2) ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I am aware that such flight activities can be hazardous, and do involve certain risks and dangers that cannot be completely eliminated, including both those associated with (a) the piloting and operation of the helicopter; and (b) to the helicopter itself.

Specifically, I am aware that the flight activities have the potential to (a) impose physical stress upon and cause other physiological efforts to the occupants, including, in some cases, injury. I am nevertheless voluntarily participating in the flight activities with knowledge of the risks involved at my own risk. I am competent to and assume these risks of my own free will. I accept any and all risks of death, bodily injury and property damage

Initial ____ **3) WAIVER AND RELEASE:** As consideration for being permitted to participate in the flight activities, I agree that neither I nor my assignees, heirs, distributes, executors, guardians, or legal representatives ("releasors") will make a claim, or assert any causes of action (known or unknown) against, or sue Rent-A-Copter LLC., or any relates, affiliate entities, persons, directors, officers, employees, contractors, or agents ("releasees") for death, bodily injury, property damage, or any other liability of any sort ("harm") arising from flight activities, including but without limitations to harm that results from the active or passive negligence or other acts or omissions of releases. I hereby waive and release the releasees from all liability for all such claims, causes of action, and suits which releasors, or any of them now have or may hereafter have. This waiver and release include without limitation: harm which results from (a) my being in the helicopter which could cause an accident (b) negligent training, instruction or supervision of me, which could cause injury to me and/or an accident, and (c) my slipping, falling, or otherwise becoming injured on and about the helicopter.

Initial ____ **4) SERVES PROVISIONS AND LIMITATIONS:** I HAVE CAREFULLY READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE, AND HAVE SIGNED IT OF MY OWN FREE WILL. I AGREE THAT NO ORAL REPRESENTATIONS, STATEMENTS OR INDUCEMENTS APART FROM THE FOREGOING WRITTEN AGREEMENT HAVE BEEN MADE.

I further agree to the following terms and limitations to the above service:

- The release affirms that they weigh less than 240 pounds (R22), 300 pounds (R44), and that they have **accurately represented their weight as _____**.
- The release affirms that they have not had any alcoholic beverages in the last 8 hours.
- The release affirms that they will pay attention to the authorized instructor/pilot, and will follow the direction of said instructor/pilot
- The release affirms that after starting, any cancellations will be done without the benefit of a refund
- The release affirms that flight activities can be terminated at any time at the sole discretion of the flight instructor/pilot in the interest of safety.
- The release affirms that all refunds (full or partial) are at the sole discretion of representatives of Rent-A-Copter LLC

Any violation of said limitations is cause for immediate termination of activities without refund.

Initial ____ **5) DATA PRIVACY AGREEMENT:** As part of the participation in Rent-A-Copter LLC helicopter flight operations and activities, or related services, I acknowledge and agree to the following:

5a) Authorization to Capture and Use Media: I understand and agree that such photographs and other media may be captured before, during, and after flight activities, including but not limited to check-in, safety passenger briefings, boarding, loading and unloading of the helicopter, ground operations, landings, post-flight activities, and while present at or around Rent-A-Copter LLC rotorcraft, equipment, facilities, or event locations.

5b) Online Portal Access and Security: Any account credentials, passwords, access codes, or login information provides by Rent-A-Copter LLC are for personal use only and shall not be shared with any third party. Rent-A-Copter LLC reserves the right to modify, suspend, restrict, or terminate access to any online portal, website, or digital platform at any time.

I understand that Rent-A-Copter may use such information for customer communications and recordkeeping for current and future operations.

5c) Limitations of Liability: To the fullest extent permitted by law, Rent-A-Copter LLC shall not be liable for website downtime, service interruptions, technical malfunctions, cybersecurity incidents, unauthorized access, data loss, transmission failures, or any other issues relating to the storage, transmission, or delivery of photographs or other media through electronic platforms.

I understand that electronic communications and services involve inherent risks and agree the Rent-A-Copter shall not be responsible for damages arising from circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

Initial ____ I ALSO CERTIFY THAT I HAVE NO REASON TO BELIEVE THAT I HAVE ANY PHYSICAL OR MENTAL LIMITATIONS WHICH MAY PREVENT ME FROM SAFELY PARTICIPATING IN THE FLIGHT ACTIVITIES. I CERTIFY THAT I AM OVER THE AGE OF 21, UNLESS MY PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN HAS SIGNED BELOW.

DO NOT SIGN THIS WAIVER & RELEASE BEFORE YOU HAVE CAREFULLY READ IT AND UNDERSTAND THAT IT IS A RELEASE OF LEGAL AUTHORITY. IT IS A LEGALLY BINDING CONTRACT BY WHICH YOU WILL BE BOUND, PREVENTING YOU FROM BRINGING ANY LEGAL ACTION TO ASSERT A CLAIM AGAINST RENT-A-COPTER LLC FOR ANY HARM.
